Magnetic particle and/or visual inspections were completed on all accessible areas of the body, door, latch, secondary latch, hinge pin, latch pin, secondary latch pin, latch spring, and secondary latch spring.

Based on the inspections, it is our opinion that the unit is safe to operate within its rated capacity when used in accordance with the manufacturers' specifications and/or industry standards.

In accordance with C.A.O.D.C. RP-2.0, a certification period of 500 operating days is recommended. Due to the nature of Canyon's business, this **certification is valid for a period of 2 years** or until the unit has been damaged structurally by either handling or operation. Unengineered structural modifications to this unit will void this certification.
